For a taste of something classic, Lai Po Heen has prepared three menus to choose from: Fortune; Prosperity; and Wealth. When we think of reunion dinners and Chinese New Year lunches, we think of big groups seated at round tables. At Lai Po Heen, it's the company that counts, and as little as a party of two can enjoy the individually-plated Wealth menu. The Fortune and Prosperity menus are both made up of eight courses for a minimum of four diners.



The time-honoured tradition of tossing yee sang comes in five varieties — abalone with assorted vegetables, pan seared scallops and snow pear, soft shell crab and snow pear, salmon with assorted vegetable, and assorted vegetables with shredded fruits. All Yee Sang are available in half and full portions, with the option for takeaway.
