MUJI Malaysia, the Japanese brand known for its various products from furniture to food, has opened its seventh branch at Suria KLCC.

The store officially opened its doors last week where inside comprises 7,000 square feet of retail with a warm and relaxing ambience complete with interior and display fixtures made from natural materials.

The Suria KLCC branch is aimed to be Malaysia's pre-eminent Muji store with special services that also includes health and beauty items, make-up tester tables and interior adviser service.

The company started with just 38 items in its first store in Japan, and now it carries 3,000 items in Malaysia for consumers here, Takagi added.

Muji is growing at a steady pace and is located in 28 countries worldwide to promote the Japanese way of living.

"We find people in Malaysia to be very receptive of our products and that the most popular items here are the same ones in Japan and Singapore. We are confident that we can expand our business here for the locals," she said.

Other products in Muji include footwear, travel items, luggage, furniture, food and home accessories.
